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WHEN CAN I RETURN TO SCHOOL?

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 DAYS FROM DATE OF 1ST SYMPTOM
AND
AT LEAST 24 HOURS NO FEVER WITHOUT TAKING MEDICINE
AND
SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED

NO COVID-19 TEST

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 DAYS FROM DATE OF 1ST SYMPTOM
AND
AT LEAST 24 HOURS NO FEVER WITHOUT MEDICINE
AND
SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED
OR
DOCTOR'S NOTE INDICATING ALTERNATE DIAGNOSIS

NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST

MAY RETURN AFTER AT LEAST 24 HOURS WITHOUT TAKING MEDICINE
AND
RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS (COUGH, BREATHING) HAVE IMPROVED

EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

MAY RETURN AFTER 14 DAYS
AND
WITH NO SYMPTOMS

*EVEN WITH NEGATIVE TEST, 14 DAYS IS REQUIRED IF EXPOSED

- IF VOMITING OR DIARRHEA IS THE **ONLY** SYMPTOM, MAY RETURN AFTER 24 HOURS WITHOUT MEDICINE
- INFORMATION AS OF 08/18/2020 AND IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE. WILL UPDATE ACCORDINGLY
